Our last update was in January so we have a lot to cover. It has been a very busy year for us. Not so much for regular NICAP work, but UAP research in general. I spent a lot of time updating my research papers. A must-see is the one on the NICAP Archive.

My focus, of course, has been the MADAR Project which has turned out to be more valuable, more interesting, more time-consuming than anything I have ever done. Thank God I have such a great team and over 270 project members. The MADAR Network continues to grow in the United States, and 11 countries including Australia, Canada, France, Germany, Ireland, Japan, the Netherlands, Philippines, Switzerland, the United Kingdom and Norway. The MADAR Project currently has 224 sites, with 173 running and 51 in various stages. Presently, 66, or 29% are now DAS-equipped, which means the site teams can be alerted by an alarm system, go out and gather more data with selected equipment. Very soon anyone with a GMC-500 geiger counter will be able to plug this device into their MADAR and have readings logged right on their spreadsheets! And more surprises are in the works.
