

Flying Sphere Seen at Yakima

Yakima, Wash., July 25.—(U.P.)—A silvery "moonsized" object wheeled over Yakima Sunday bringing comments from civil aeronautics observers of "another flying saucer."

C.A.A. communications veterans at the Yakima air field reported seeing the silver ball-shaped object flying west over the city. They said it could not have been a weather balloon because it was flying against the wind.

Two C.A.A. men reported they watched the object for almost an hour around 2 p.m. Sunday and then they saw it again around 4:30 p.m. They said the second time it was flying lower and seemed to have "flashing lights, like fog lights."

The flying sphere was first seen about 10 a.m. Sunday by Farmer Victor Kroum of Punkin Center, Wash. He reported it to a Washington state patrolman.

The patrolman also said he saw the silver ball and notified the C.A.A. tower at Yakima.

C.A.A. officials reported they received calls from all over the Yakima county area and surrounding counties inquiring about the flying object. The visibility was unlimited around Yakima Sunday.
