

FLYING SAUCER EXPERT

A man who is not only a leading authority on flying saucers but who has even seen one, is loose on the Vallejo Junior College campus. It is Clif DeLacy who armed with proof may seen at any time cornering saucers sceptics and giving them the word.

Saucers have been a hobby with Clif since 1947 when he started to collect clippings from publications concerning actual news on the flying objects or features and comics concerning them. He now has a collection of several hundred items ranging from accounts of actual trips into space to debunking articles from government authorities.

The earliest report comes from 1500 BC when according to records found recently eye witnesses described saucers zooming around their heads and received the same scoffing remarks as present day sky gazers.

The earliest reports from the bay area were dated 1896 when passengers on the Oakland trolley were buzzed by a flying object. What the Oakland Tribune reported as "reliable witnesses" described the object as cigar shaped with a stream of light from the front. After having inspected the Oakland transit system the space ship buzzed off in the direction of Los Angeles and evidently grew discouraged for no report was heard of it after that.

One of the most interesting articles is a report by a George Adamski who describes his trip into outer space on a saucer. He was picked up, invited to go for a ride, and was taken into outer space to the tender ship where he talked with a number of aliens, dined with some space beings, and was returned to earth with pictures and was given a message in space writing which he

brought back with him. Authorities, it is said, are still trying to decipher the note.

Clif claims that he and two friends spotted a saucer themselves over Vallejo and watch it depart at an estimated speed of over 1500 miles per hour.

Although Clif doesn't take his hobby too seriously and points out that most of the stories are 90% hoax and only about 10% unexplained phenomena. That 10% though, he feels, is important for it contains reports by trained observers who have seen what they feel were actual visitors from outer space.

The scrap book of clippings is available to interested parties but Clif is understandably reluctant to loan it. His scrap book was loaned to him again.

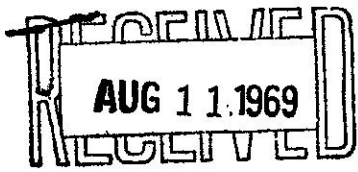

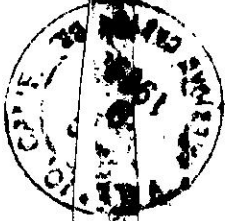

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Dear Bob:

Thank you for your telephone call made by your secretary this morning (approx. 9:30 a.m.). You were lucky enough to call on a day off. She had called just as I awoke, asking if I had received your letter. I had not, so she asked if I would send the Delacy film to you. I received your letter just a few minutes ago. Enclosed is the information on the film that I have. It consists of: three clippings, 5 page NICAP form and additional information, 2 UFO RC letters, 1 affidavit (Mr. Delacy requested this before he would send us a copy), 1 two-page letter from Mr. Delacy, 2 other one-page reports from Delacy.
