MEMORANDUM FOR THE SECRETARY, JOINT INTELLIGENCE COMMITTEE

SUBJECT: Communication Instructions for Reporting Military Intelligence Sightings (CIRNIS) -- JANAP 116.

1. In view of certain problems encountered incident to implementation of JANAP 116, copy inclosed, the Director of Communications of this Headquarters has requested that the document be tabled at joint intelligence level for review and recommendations. Although presumably promulgated to satisfy an intelligence need, subject document was published without prior coordination with any intelligence agency.

2. Action has been taken to insure full implementation of JANAP 116 within the Air Force. However, in view of various international implications which might arise as a result of involving U. S. commercial airlines abroad in overt intelligence collection and reporting activities, no implementing action with reference to commercial airlines has been taken by the Department of the Air Force. Informal discussion with representatives of the Department of State have revealed strong objections to CIRNIS provisions for utilising commercial overseas airlines as sources of information.

3. If it is determined by the Joint Intelligence Committee that a requirement exists for a joint publication such as JANAP 116, the following specific items are among matters which will require satisfactory resolution.

a. Scope. Should commercial airlines participate in implementation?

b. Security. Should the document be carried in military aircraft while flying over foreign territory? Should all sightings "which may be of military intelligence value" be transmitted in the clear?

c. What specific information should be reported by CIRNIS procedures?

SUGGESTED RECOMMENDATION FOR THE APPROVAL OF THE BUDGET AND
THE 2008 PROPOSED AND APPROVED BUDGETARY MONITORING
AND REVIEW - (BMR) AGAINST THE APPROVED BUDGET

AS IT IS RECOMMENDED, THE BUDGET AND BMR ARE AS FOLLOWS:
The proposed budgetary amounts outlined below are to be used as the
maximum limit for expenditure and therefore types will result in substantial
increases and/or decreases and expenditures will be submitted
separately from the original budgetary amounts which will be issued as
a separate document or by letter of communication. The BMR will be
submitted once budgetary amounts are proposed, accepted, and
agreed upon by the Board of Education.

The recommended BMR amounts are based upon revised 2008
estimates to reflect all approved amounts and actuals up to date
and to reflect a more accurate and the most realistic budgetary amount
and expenditure figures as budgeted amounts reflect the actuals
of the previous year. The proposed BMR amounts are anticipated
to provide additional and confirm information of expenditures
to service providers and the community members, which will aid in the
use of existing funds available and assist in determining who
receives the available resources available and who
