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at 23kmg (19th) Controller Nugent called my attention to several targets observed on the VC-2 scope. Eight of them were counted and, although an occasional strong return was noted, most of the targets would be classified as fair to weak. After we had checked carefully on the movement (about 100 to 130 mph) and confirmed our findings with what the Tower saw on the ASR, I called MFS and reported it. This was about midnight EST. MFS later advised that the nearest military base was supposed to handle these matters and to-call the BOF Intelligence Officer or AO. There was some confusion for awhile as to whether andrews or Bolling was going to make the report, but it was finally determined that ADA would handle.

(This took place after 0505E) At about 0530E Controller Ritchey reported seeing 10 targets in the vicinity of ADS which was confirmed by the other man in radar and I went in and counted 7 or 8 in scattered positions which indicated a very rapid movement if they were the same ones seen near ADS. This report was forwarded to both ADS and AFS. It was at this time that AFS advised they had determined that none of the information we had been giving to ADS was forwarded in accordance with procedures. MFS advised however, that they were following up with their own report.
