BLUE TRIANGLE LATEST THING SEEN IN DISKS

Something new in mysterious flying objects—this time a fluttering black or dark blue triangle—was reported seen yesterday over Boeing Field.

Bruce Armstrong, experimental electronics technician for Boeing Aircraft Company, said that he and a number of other Boeing engineers and technicians saw the queer object during a rest period at about 2:20 p. m.

"It seemed to be fluttering like a leaf, and slowly gaining altitude and speed," Armstrong, 4038 E. 56th St., said. "It appeared to be higher than the top of Beacon Hill, and travelling parallel to the Boeing Field runway.

"It was rough on one side, and definitely not round," Armstrong continued. "I'd say it was triangular and maybe 15 feet across."

Also reported was another flying disc, this one, seen by M. A. Nichols, 1125 S. W. 102d St. Nichols said he saw it through binoculars as a "big ball," sunlight shining on it giving it a purplish tinge. It was headed south, he said.
