OBSERVER BELIEVES IF THE OBJECT WERE 100 FEET IN DIAMETER THE ALTITUE COULD BE ESTIMATED AT 30,000 FEET AND THE DISTANCE AT 15 TO 20 MILES; OBJECT APPEARED TO BE ONE-HALF INCH LONG AND APPROXIMATELY THREE-SIXTEENTH INCH WIDE AT THE THICK EDGE; THIS HQ BEEN SIMULATED BY EXTENDING A PENCIL PERPENDICULAR TO THE LINE OF SIGHT AND AT ARM'S LENGTH AWAY FROM THE EYE.
