

Tombaugh Sighting

Las Cruces, New Mexico: Professor Clyde Tombaugh sees rectangular array of six-to-eight glowing rectangles pass silently and rapidly overhead--apparently glowing apertures in bottom of some rigid object. On January 17, 1957, Tombaugh has reaffirmed his conviction that UFOs are real and may well be of extra-solar origin.
