UAP sighting reports of the type that would be interesting to scientists and other serious UFOlogists are relatively rare. Recently there were some extremely interesting UAP reports near some MADAR sites. However, the sites were found to have been offline. Not only is this embarrassing but it should be a good reason why an Op would want to be running 24/7.

MADAR DAILY OFFLINE REPORT

The MADAR Operations Officer, and the MADAR Project Continuity Officer both get a server-generated MADAR Daily Offline Report which lists the node number, software version number, email address, city, state, date and time of last contact.

IMMEDIATE NOTICE TO OPS

MADAR Operators who unplug their devices for some form of maintenance or for the installation of some new item, get a notification of being offline. Once they are back online and within 24 hours the O/L notices cease.

ISSUES TO REPORT ASAP

- 1) MADAR Dataprobe offline with no known cause or reason
- 2) Offline or restricted use due to high anomaly rate.
- 3) Not receiving alerts, either DAS, email alerts or phone SMS notifications.
- 4) No red LED (power status indicator)
- 5) No green or amber LED (no internet connection)
- 6) Wifi issues if not connected by ethernet.

Steve Foss, the MADAR Project Continuity Officer, is a very dedicated and helpful member of the team. His job includes getting nodes moved from one place to another, making sure the data history follows the MADAR site and not the owners.
