# FALSE ALARMS

## How To Treat Them

If by chance you bump a MADAR device and set it off, please let us know. Your device will have other false alarms or uncorrelated targets that may never be solved, and that's part of the business. If you need to move the MADAR, or touch it for any reason, unplug the power adaptor AT THE OUTLET or surge protector first. Then move the device and replug.

### ALIBI

- 1) To file a false alarm or alibi, just drop us a brief note. The best way is to send us a copy of the alert email.
- 2) You will get an alert email that has everything we need to know about the alert. If the alert was a false alarm, please print a copy of that email and write on it, "FALSE ALARM", and place it in a FALSE ALARM FOLDER. Since we are unable to keep track of false alarms with 200 nodes, if a UAP report turns up or is found on the NUFORC or CMS listings we'll know if your alert was genuine.
