

## MADAR TIME ANOMALIES WITH CODE BLUES?

With the usual UAP reports with MADAR data such as magnetometer spikes, there are no alert time anomalies. But so far, alertStart time issues show up in every "code blue" of all documented correlations.

Every single documented code blue anomaly has a time anomaly. This is something one must take into consideration with sightings because there could be an association. It is possible, however, that this could show up in routine NON-correlation code blues. This is more difficult to check. The best way would be to have a node Op who watches his false alarms to check some of them, but prior to 2023, just to be safe,

So far there have been eleven documented code blues with bonified correlations. Keep in mind, everyone has had code blues. We're looking at code blues that have been determined to be associated with real UAP activity.

Looking at code blues with false alarm tags it will interesting to see if that group has any time questions.

### Number 1

May 11, 2018 - Marysville, Washington

The first one occurred right after we became operational in 2018. The MADAR operator of site 100 at Mountlake Terrace, Washington had gotten an alert email stating there was a magnetic anomaly at 04:59:27 GMT " which is 10:59:27 pm PDT., a full-blown "code blue". Site 100 was not yet DAS equipped so there was no audio alarm. A couple of days later, he submitted a request for any UAPs in the MUFON Case Management System, and someone had indeed filed a report on 5/13. There had been a sighting at Marysville, Washington, about 22 miles NE of the MADAR site as the crow flies. The MUFON report stated that at 9:58 pm a light as bright as a normal star/satellite appeared and disappeared as it traveled northward in a snakelike manner. For some reason the MADAR got locked in alert so we don't know how long the alert lasted, but there was a noticeable time anomaly right before the alertStart. The status showed 04:58:44 UTC, followed by the alertStart at 04:59:27 UTC, a 43 second discrepancy.

### Number 2

August 6, 2018 - Norwich, Connecticut

A 1:05 pm EDT the witness reported that he saw what appeared to be a helicopter, free-fall to hover over the trees about a quarter mile from his building less than 1000 feet up. It moved side to side [falling leaf motion] as if troubled with control. He thought it was going to crash, then it turned sideways and the

sun shone off it brightly. At this point he realized that It was not a helicopter and seemed possibly bullet shaped, and a bright chrome. It continued to attempt control then steadied itself for a few seconds before flying straight up above the clouds. Six minutes later at 17:11:36 UTC or 1:11 pm and 40 miles away to the NW, the Newington node 106 had a verified anomaly! This is the only code blue event we have with no spreadsheet to support it. The important thing here is the data suggests a vertical descent and the report documents a vertical ascent.

#### Number Three

September 28, 2019 - Fishers, Indiana. This one involved a vertical ascent observed with night vision at Fisher's, Indiana. MADAR Operations was working with the op at site 84 and the shield was set at 15, actually too low, but it allowed for the detection and discovery of unidentified night vision targets. The alerts lasted as short as 4 seconds but there was no time anomaly found on the spreadsheet.

#### Number Four

April 23, 2020 - Millerton, Pennsylvania. MADAR ops in radio shack were startled by a code blue alert, went outside, were involved in close encounter with animal reactions (cattle and dogs) and two 20-30' reddish-yellow spheres maneuvering around some grain silos. The alert lasted 6 secs but the sighting lasted 10 minutes! There was a 9 sec dataloss so the event time was more like 15 secs.

#### Number Five

August 29, 2020, Payson, Illinois. Two witnesses, one a MADAR Op, observed a bright object in the west, apparently struck by the setting sun. Later the Op discovered that site his MADAR site 97 had a documented anomaly at the exact time they observed the unknown target. The alert lasted 7 seconds but there was a time discrepancy of 14 seconds, making the total event 21 seconds.

#### Number Six

October 11, 2020. Millerton, Pennsylvania. Alert lasted 7 seconds. Prior to that there was a time discrepancy of 48 secs. Total 55 secs. The "ham operators" who run MADAR node 104 were alerted when their DAS alarm sounded at 5:58 am EDT. and they responded according to standard protocol. They immediately went outside the "radio shack" and observed a bright object above the clouds. There was heavy cloud cover that morning and the witnesses thought the object they were seeing above those clouds was actually the moon. Later, the main node op realized that the moon would have been on the other side of the facility in the NW.

### Number Seven

January 10, 2021; Festus, Missouri. 9:00 am. CST. The primary witness and a buddy were taking a walk in the woods near his house. His buddy sighted the silver disc craft first, and using their cell phone zoomed in on the object and started taking 3 pictures. After hovering for about 5 minutes, the craft moved at unbelievable speed, first left, then right, then zoomed up and away as the witness described it "at a speed faster than anything they had ever seen". The nearby MADAR site at St. Louis, Missouri, node 70, 30 miles to the SE recorded two anomalies, the first being a "code blue" correlation with the sighting at Festus. The time of the sighting was estimated as being 9:00 am but the MADAR alertStart was documented at 15:10:47 UTC or 9:10 CST. This anomaly lasted about 6 seconds during the suggested "entry" phase and it appears to have reverted to normal readings after the UAP idled down. There was however a 28 second discrepancy, making the entire episode a 34 sec event.

### Number Eight

January 17, 2021 at Lee's Summit, Missouri. 1:18 pm CST. According to the witness the object was about the length of a football field, black, stealth-like with angular features.. Described as similar to tall building on its side, with each level flat on the bottom and coming to a tip near the 'front'. Object was seen about 300 feet above the ground and less tha 2 miles away. By the time witness got to the intersection at Lees Summit Drive and NW Vellie Rd, object had dropped to approximately 100 feet (just above tree line) and was about 1.2 miles away. At that exact same time a MADAR site twelve miles to the north, node 45 at Independence had a spike on its magnetometer. But that was just the beginning. Twenty minutes later that same site had a full-blown code blue at 1:39 pm or 19:39:17 UTC and lasted for nine minutes. No time anomalies noted.

### Number Nine

September 6, 2021; Indianapolis, Indiana. At 6:25 a.m. The MADAR site 21 had a code blue. Using social media media he was able to find an excellent witness. The witness was a retired Marion County and State Capitol Police officer, and at the time of the sighting, an Uber driver, sitting at the corner of Thompson Road and Emerson Avenue in the old Kmart parking lot. Witness facing West saw a silent black cigar-shaped craft with 7 round white lights on the trailing edge of the object. The alert lasted 32 seconds. With a prior 46 sec discrepancy the event lasted 78 secs.

### Number 10

October 9, 2022, Newington, Connecticut. Another 6 sec alert but with a 12 sec loss of time, 18 sec event. At 5:57 pm EDT, the MADAR Operator for Node 106

received an SMS (cell phone text "short message service") alert which stated that site 106 had detected an anomaly. Trained as part of a rapid deployment team he immediately grabbed his binoculars and went outside to his backyard to see if he could spot anything unusual. At first the only thing that he saw was a few aircraft flying by, and as he was looking through his binoculars at one the planes he spotted a small round black object descending from the clouds above the plane and ascending back up. It repeated this maneuver twice as if trying to stay concealed in the clouds.

#### Number Eleven

March 22, 2023, Royal Palm Beach, Florida. 6 sec alert 29 sec time loss 35 sec total. At approximately 06:45 AM EST the witness was taking care of his neighbor's dog and went outside into the back yard that faces north. Coming in from the west to east he quickly noticed a distant object that was a bright non-pulsating light which appeared to drop down out of the clouds to the northeast and travel northwest at a high rate of speed. The estimated distance was 4 to 6 miles from where he stood. He thought at first it went into the clouds, however it was below the clouds, and It accelerated at a high speed to the northwest. Around 8:30 AM the same day he was reviewing his incoming emails and discovered he had a MADAR alert at 6:49 AM Eastern Standard Time.
