The chrono has a brief reference to an Australian sighting dated Jan 3 1955. I'd like to submit the following item to replace the current item.

Jan, 3, 1955 AUSTRALIA, Melbourne

Two persons in a car saw a flying object come within 70 metres of them after their vehicle was stopped.

(Source: Vallee, J. Passport to Magonia. p.248. Catalogue number 359.)

Notes:

1. Vallee cites his source as 'Quincy.' On p.167 Vallee states this is Guy Quincy who circulated his own catalogues in France in 1961.
2. However, Vallee, writing about Quincy says that "Original references, unfortunately, were not given in his catalogues."
3. Keith Basterfield has no references to such an event in his Australian catalogues.
4. The National Library of Australia TROVE digitised Australian newspaper collection stops in 1954.
5. Keith Basterfield has found no reference to such a sighting in any Australian UFO periodicals.
